Goal of bursary

To provide financial support through the entire four-year program to a student with outstanding academic credentials who lacks the financial means to attend The Canadian College of Naturopathic Medicine.

Details

The scholarship will consist of the following:

- \$5,000 annual award for four years paid in yearly installments at the beginning of each semester
- Required textbooks and equipment provided by BMS Resources for four years (average annual value of \$1,500)
- Employment at BMS Resources for an average minimum of one four-hour shift per week throughout the four-year ND program (minimum annual income of \$3,000)

Criteria

The recipient is required to:

- Have a minimum undergraduate average of 80 per cent
- Have participated in volunteer organizations
- Establish a clear need for additional financial assistance
- Be registered as a Year 1 student in CCNM's ND program beginning in January 2007

The recipient must submit:

- University transcripts
- Current resume/CV
- Admissions essay
- Personal statement
- Financial information
