2007 Standard Process Whole Food Nutrition Scholarship

The Institute for Natural Medicine (INM), a philanthropic foundation founded in 1993 for the purpose of promoting naturopathic education and research, is proud to announce the **Standard Process Whole Food Nutrition Scholarship** program for naturopathic medical students. INM will award a **\$2500.00** scholarship for **2007** to a naturopathic medical student. Selection of the scholarship recipient will be competitive and based upon papers written by the candidates on such topics as scholarly research, clinical case studies, scientific research and education methodology pertaining to whole food nutrition. Additionally, recipients will be invited to participate in a one week extern rotation in the Standard Process Graduate Education Program at the expense of Standard Process. Students from each of the following programs are eligible to apply to receive an award:

Canadian College of Naturopathic Medicine
Southwest College of Naturopathic Medicine
Bastyr University
National College of Naturopathic Medicine
Boucher Institute

Who is eligible?

- ◆ You must be enrolled full-time in a CNME accredited (or candidate for accreditation) naturopathic doctoral program.
- ◆ You must have completed at least one year of study, and have a sustained record of outstanding scholastic achievement. Incoming first-year students are not eligible to apply.
- ◆ You must have demonstrated a strong commitment studying, investigating or practicing with the whole food nutrition perspective.
- ◆ INM celebrates diversity. All students are encouraged to apply.

How do I apply?

The **Standard Process Whole Food Nutrition Scholarship** will be awarded on Wednesday, **May 30, 2007**. Applications will be available on Monday, March 19, 2007, and may be obtained through the financial aid offices at any institution that offers a CNME accredited naturopathic doctoral program, or on-line at www.naturemed.org.

Applications and all attachments must be returned to the institution's financial aid office no later than 5 p.m. Monday, April 16, 2007 to be considered. No late applications will be accepted.

Please follow the application directions carefully. Incomplete or incorrect applications will not be considered.

The Selection Committee will make the final determination for the awarding of the scholarships based on the established criteria. **The recipient will be announced on May 30, 2007.**
